Dear Ms. Bernier:

On October 2, 2023, Alaska Universal Service Administrative Company (AUSAC) filed TA42-998, related to the Alaska Universal Service Fund (AUSF) surcharge factor and the AUSAC's 2024 operating budget. With TA42-998, AUSAC also proposed revisions to its tariff reflecting the phase-out of Dial Equipment Minute support and regulatory changes promulgated with Order No. R-21-001(10). On November 2, 2023, the Regulatory Commission of Alaska approved TA42-998, which retains the current 10 percent AUSF surcharge and approved AUSAC's 2024 budget for administering the AUSF.

The Commission further approved Tariff Sheet Nos. 4, 8, 9, 10, 12, 14, 15, 17, 23, 24, 25, 25.1, 26 and 29, filed October 2, 2023, with TA42-998. Please note that the margin notations have been updated in accordance with 3 AAC 48.360(g). The effective date of the tariff sheets is January 1, 2024, as requested by AUSAC.

Enclosed are validated copies of the approved tariff sheets.

#### **DEFINITION OF TERMS**

<u>End User</u>: Any customer of an intrastate telecommunications service who is not a carrier, except that a carrier shall be deemed to be an "end user" to the extent that such carrier uses a telecommunications service for administrative purposes, without making such service available to others, directly or indirectly.

<u>End User Revenue</u>: Amounts billed to End Users for purchase of intrastate telecommunications services.

<u>Essential Network Support:</u> Payments made from the Alaska Universal Service Fund to qualifying carriers for support previously classified as Carrier Common Line and Carrier of Last Resort in accordance with 3 AAC 53.346 that is in effect on September 15, 2023.

<u>Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier</u>: A Local Exchange Carrier certificated by the Commission and providing local exchange service as of February 8, 1996, or its successor.

Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP): A service that (1) enables real-time, two-way voice communications; (2) requires a broadband connection from the user's location; (3) requires Internet protocol-compatible customer premises equipment; and (4) permits users generally to receive calls that originate on the PSTN and to terminate calls to the PSTN. VoIP has the same meaning as set out in 47 C.F.R. § 9.3 that is effective on March 1, 2017.

<u>Intrastate Telecommunications Carrier</u>: Any provider of telecommunications service that originates and terminates within Alaska, for a fee directly to the public or to such classes of users as to be effectively available to the public.

<u>Local Exchange Carrier</u>: An Intrastate Telecommunications Carrier engaged in the business of providing telecommunications service to the public through one or more local telephone exchanges.

<u>Non-Pooling Company</u>: A company that is not a participant in the access charge pool established by the Alaska Intrastate Interexchange Access Charge Manual.

<u>Pooling Company</u>: A company that is a participant in the access charge pool established by the Alaska Intrastate Interexchange Access Charge Manual.

#### ALASKA UNIVERSAL SERVICE FUND SURCHARGE

#### A. General

Payments by Intrastate Telecommunication Carriers to the Alaska Universal Service Fund are collected in the form of a surcharge on intrastate End User Revenues of Subject Carriers. Carriers may recover the surcharge from ratepayers through a line item charge on their bills, identified as "Alaska Universal Service Fund Surcharge". The line item charge for concurring carriers shall be a percentage of End User Revenue billings, set at the same percentage rate that AUSAC charges to Subject Carriers.

Intrastate End User Revenues realized after June 30, 2026 are not subject to the surcharge.

Intrastate End User Revenues realized before July 1, 2026 are subject to the surcharge.

B. Carriers Subject to Payment of Surcharge

An Intrastate Telecommunications Carrier that provides telecommunications service to the public, or to those classes of users as to be effectively available to the public for a fee, shall pay a universal service surcharge to the AUSF on End User Revenues realized before July 1, 2026. Telecommunications carriers include carriers offering the following services:

- 1. Cellular telephone and paging services;
- 2. Mobile radio services;
- 3. Operator services;
- Personal communications services (PCS);
- 5. Local exchange service;
- 6. Special access service;
- 7. Wide Area Telecommunications Service (WATS);
- 8. Toll-free service;
- 9. 900 service;
- 10. Message telephone service (MTS);
- 11. Private line service;
- 12. Telex;
- 13. Telegraph;
- 14. Video services;
- 15. Satellite service:
- 16. Resale of intrastate services;
- 17. Pay phone services;
- 18. Network Access Fee accessed on end users; and
- 19. Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP)

#### E. Calculation and Approval of Annual Surcharge

On or before October 1 of each year, AUSAC shall calculate the estimated surcharge for the following calendar year and submit the requested amount of the surcharge and supporting calculations to the Commission for approval. The annual surcharge is capped at and may not exceed 10%. The annual surcharge calculation shall be made according to the following formula:

- 3. Valid claims accrued prior to July 1, 2026 may be paid. (N)
- 4. AUSAC may not pay any support claims for periods after June 30, 2026. (N)
- 5. AUSAC may not pay any claim that remains unpaid more than six months (D) (T) after accrual.
